Worship Minister Training

LEM, Acolyte, and Chalice Bearer Training for Adults

On **SUN-17-NOV** & **SUN-24-NOV**, **at both 9:15 a.m. and 11:15 a.m.**, training for these worship ministry roles will be offered for adults, in the Sanctuary.

Youth Training for Worship Ministry service

On **SUN-1-DEC at 11:15 a.m.**, training for Youth interested in serving as an Acolyte, Chalice Bearer and/or Gospel Book Bearer will be offered in the Sanctuary. Open to all High School, Middle School and 5th/6th Grade students.

What are these Worship Ministry Roles?

LEM = Lay Eucharist Minister who serves both as a Reader and as a Chalice Bearer. **Acolyte** = Person who assists the clergy during a worship service or procession. At St. Francis this includes crucifers (cross bearers), Gospel bearers, torch bearers and, on occasion, a children's cross crucifer.

Chalice Bearer = Person who, at Communion, offers one of the two chalices.



News from Ezo Diocese

We remain in regular contact with our friends in Ezo Diocese, South Sudan. Bishop Isaac tells us that they recently held their second annual Christ for Peace event, which St. Francis supported. The theme was "A Future Awaits Those Who Seek Peace" (Psalm 37:37) and was designed to reduce conflict and violence among those in Ezo and environs. 


Opera Afternoon in Collaboration with Partners for the Arts
