What are these Worship Ministry Roles?

LEM = Lay Eucharist Minister who serves both as a Reader and as a Chalice Bearer. **Acolyte** = Person who assists the clergy during a worship service or procession. At St. Francis this includes crucifers (cross bearers), Gospel bearers, torch bearers and, on occasion, a children's cross crucifer.

Chalice Bearer = Person who, at Communion, offers one of the two chalices.

2024 YEAR-TO-DATE FINANCIAL INFORMATION

As of October 31, 2024

Budgeted Revenue - \$593,960 Budgeted Expenses - \$642,271 Actual Revenue - \$560,445* Actual Expenses - \$527,250

*Includes \$52,400 in prepaid pledges received in 2023 which is not reflected in the budgeted revenue.

Since we have received only 77% of 2024 pledges, it is certainly hoped that more will come soon. Past experience tells me that many parishioners wait until the end of the year to fulfill their pledged amount. No need to wait, just send it in now! Hopefully all will come before December 31 as that is important for your tax reporting.

All pledge contributions and other donations to St. Francis must be processed within required deadlines at the end of the year. Cash/check contributions must be physically received in the

church office or postmarked by December 31, 2024. Stock contributions must be in St. Francis's investment account by December 31, and therefore should be initiated at least two weeks before the month's end to ensure timely processing.

A very successful Marketplace event took place on October 19. Many people donated their time and some of their treasures to make it happen. Income was well above the budgeted amount. Donations freely given at the Chili Cookoff along with some other contributions allowed us to send \$2,720 to Tracey Kelly's Church of the Holy Family in Mills River, North Carolina for their recovery efforts. The Outreach Committee authorized payment of several donations that were included in their budget including \$2,000 to Bishop Isaac in Ezo.

Do you wish to know where you stand on your pledge giving so that it is complete before the end of the year? Just send me an email and I'll be happy to send you an updated giving statement.

Advent Contemplative Worship 5:00 p.m. Sundays, December 1st, 8th, and 15th at St. Francis

This year St. Francis is offering a contemplative worship series on Sunday evenings during Advent, the season of stillness and preparation for the birth of the Christ child at Christmas.



Contemplative spiritual practices vary and emerge from diverse traditions. As disciplines of body and mind, they share a number of features:

- cultivation of self-awareness
- focused, non-evaluative attention

- development of mental and physical steadiness and balance
- fostering greater attunement, compassion, and creativity

Through candlelit prayer, contemplative silence, poetry, beautiful music, and Holy Communion from the Iona Celtic tradition, this service is different from what we offer on Sunday morning. A brief reflection on spiritual journey will be offered by a member of St. Francis and St. Francis' own Jamie Kim will offer soft piano music. Larry Vote will be the soloist and lead us in singing.

If you are looking for a new way to worship and a space to find your sacred center in the midst of a busy, distracted life- this may be the service for you.


