
Breakfast With Santa on 7-DEC was a Huge Success

This year St. Francis is offering a contemplative worship series on Sunday evenings during Advent, the season of stillness and preparation for the birth of the Christ child at Christmas.

Contemplative spiritual practices vary and emerge from diverse traditions. As disciplines of body and mind, they share a number of features:

- cultivation of self-awareness
- focused, non-evaluative attention
- development of mental and physical steadiness and balance
- fostering greater attunement, compassion, and creativity

Through candlelit prayer, contemplative silence, poetry, beautiful music, and Holy Communion from the Iona C tradition, this service is different from what we offer on Sunday morning. A brief reflection on spiritual journey offered by a member of St. Francis and St. Francis' own Jamie Kim will offer soft piano music. Larry Vote will be soloist and lead us in singing.
